a/ For applicants holding academic titles awarded by foreign (non-Greek) higher educational institutes, it is mandatory to provide academic recognition of their titles by the <u>Hellenic National Recognition and Information Center (NARIC)</u>. This might be a timely process, so interested applicants should start preparing their application to the NARIC foundation as soon as possible!!! If the process of the academic recognition by the NARIC foundation has not been completed till the deadline of the call for applications, the applicants should submit the proof of their application to the NARIC foundation.

b/ For applicants who are currently undergraduate students expected to complete their studies before the beginning of the MSc Program in October 2022, they may also apply for admission. Applicants belonging to this category should additionally submit with their application a certificate issued by the relevant Secretariat of their Bachelor program with all pending tasks to complete their degree. Successful applicants belonging to this category, should submit their graduation certificate during the student registration period before the beginning of the courses of the MSc Program in October 2022.
